1970	<p>Improvements to document management functionality.</p> <p><b>NOTE:</b> Due to the SharePoint structure migration complexity and potential effort required to complete the document management features upgrade, <b><u>standard upgrade path for this feature is to move to new doc. management UI ONLY.</u></b></p> <p><b>**If an existing customer requests to migrate their existing document structure to the new UI <u>PLUS</u> the new SharePoint structure, it is recommended that this is carried out as a separate continuous improvement project to the upgrade due to the potential effort required to complete the migration. The effort required will be dependent on the customer's existing SharePoint structure which will need to be reviewed and a specific effort estimate provided prior to this work commencing**</b></p> <p><b>**All consultants <u>MUST</u> ensure they have reviewed the associated migration guidance provided on the product hub with this release prior to beginning any SharePoint migration customer project planning.</b></p> <p>The above does not impact deployment of new customer development environments if no SharePoint structure migrations are required.</p>
